Hey. Sup? Here's your study guide.

There is a bunch of vocabulary on page 483. You should probably know that. Then...

Study everything (read) from page 483 to 496. I already taught this so if you want the condensed version check out the power point (WWII part 1) on my website. If you skim this chapter while looking at the power point you should be ok.

Next! Vocabulary on page 506. Then read pages 506-516. Again, I made a power point for this. If you skim while looking at the power point (WWII part 2) you should be ok.

I put a link to the article we read in class on the website as well. Feel free to read it again.

ALSO: There are questions on pages 487, 490, 494, 495, 496, 508, 511, 515, and 516. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO ANSWER THEM ON PAPER, however you should be able to answer the questions in some form if asked. So, read them in case some form of them show up again on the test. ALSO! On page 488 there are dictators. Study that graphic.

So, in summary. Know your vocabulary. Skim (or read thoroughly) the chapters again. Review the power points and be able to answer the questions at the ends of each chapter (or unit). Pay attention to the who, the what, the when and the where. The why is important but that is something that you should have gotten in class from the lesson.
