

### **Rubric for Urbanization Jigsaw:**

**Objective:** This is where you generally state what you are attempting to teach.

**For example:** Today all the students that I teach will understand and be able to answer questions correctly about Global Cities. (or whatever you are teaching) Determine five vocabulary words or concepts that you think are crucial to understanding your topic. (Remember, I have vocabulary to go with this section. You can look there.)

**Procedure:** I will do, A: B: and C: to make certain that all students learn what was stated in the objective.

**For example:** I will give students a list of vocabulary words that are important to the content I am teaching. I will ask questions (pre-load) at the beginning of the lesson and then again at the end. They will know they are getting tested at the end, so they are likely to pay attention. (Most of you will be doing this through lecture.)

**Materials:** You will use your article and any visuals you need to.

**Review and Demonstration of Knowledge:** You will be presenting your lesson with vocabulary given in advance. At the end of your teaching you should ask each person one at a time to explain the vocabulary word you have given them. If they cannot explain it back, they don't know it. Re teach it to them.

**Other notes:** Make certain your learning group takes notes. There will be a quiz on Edmodo about this information. If they take notes it should be easy.
